2. One-time national dues are \$15.00 for membership throughout your medical school career. Chapter dues are charged in some states, and some chapters pay all or part of student dues. Call the number below to find out if your constituent chapter pays for student dues.
3. Do not send dues— you will be invoiced.
4. Membership terminates upon graduation. If you desire to maintain AAFP membership, you must reapply for resident status.
