REQUIREMENTS:

1. A minimum of one elective from each **MAJOR CATEGORY**.
2. Of the five (5) required electives, no more than three may be from any one **MAJOR CATEGORY**.
3. If three electives are in any one **MAJOR CATEGORY**, no more than two may be from the same **SUBCATEGORY**.
4. Of the five required electives, at least one must be a critical care elective from any of the three (3) major **CATEGORIES**, but no more than two critical care electives maybe taken.
5. Only one **category** requirement elective can be three weeks.
6. Two-week electives do not meet any category requirement.
7. Away electives may meet the category requirements if taken in a LCME accredited school and a description is provided in the Office of Health Professions Education.
8. All schedules must be balanced. **Meeting all the requirements does not necessarily constitute an approved balanced schedule.** The PDAT advisors and the Practice of Medicine Team reviews schedules for balance. Balanced programs have:
  - advanced experiences in "**hands-on**" patient management, **continuity** of care,
  - electives in various disciplines,
  - no more than two of the same specialty can be in the basic five electives.

Examples of electives that would **not** be approved:

- Two Adult Emergency Medicine electives and one Pediatric Emergency Medicine elective
- Orthopaedic Surgery, Orthopaedic Trauma Surgery, and Pediatric Orthopaedics
